The last part of our student leadership elections will occur with electing our Junior Campus Captains. This will be from the current Y8 cohort who will be in Y9 in 2019. We will elect one female and one male captain on the junior campus. We will then elect our SRC for 2019 from Years 7-10. This will involve 4 students from each year group.

Pratham G Captain's speech:

LE-ADE-RS-HIP. Leadership. What is it about? What is a leader. A leader is someone who makes others better as a result of their presence and makes sure the impact lasts in their absence.

It was only two years ago that I was talking about legacy, trying to convince you of how I wanted to make this school's legacy, together. "If opportunity doesn't knock, build a door" I stand here today proud, that I have been given the chance to build that door, but I am far more honoured to open and take that first step through that door with everyone here today.

To me a Captain isn't just a person who is a voice for those who haven't been heard, but rather it is a person who makes sure that they are the ones who get to voice their concerns and collaborates with them to create efficient and realistic solutions. It is a figure who is approachable, adaptable, and confident in having the ability to advocate for people with completely different views to themselves. It is someone with the confidence to have tough conversations without shattering the glass, and more importantly a captain is a person who isn't afraid of humility.

Abby B Captain's speech:

As we move across two campuses, it is essential that we maintain a sense of community. As Senior Captain, I will work with our Junior Captains to make sure that all students are represented. We will coordinate regular meetings between the Junior and Senior SRCs, working together and utilising our strength in numbers to reach shared goals.

A Captain is also expected to represent our school to our community. Many of us have strong ties to other schools in our area, and it is my firm belief that we must cultivate these relationships so that all can benefit from them. Whether it be from collaborating on academic projects with North Sydney Boys to advocating for environmental causes with Monte, all schools in our area have something to offer. Mobile Phone Policy

As all parents / caregivers would be aware our policy on mobile phones has been very clear and consistently implemented since the school's foundation in 2015. Can I remind parents to support the school on our policy with your child.

The policy is that no phones are to be out during class time or break times. This is to support our students from distractions and to support cyber safety within the school day.

Can I request that parents minimise calls to students during the school day as many students are telling us they are speaking with mum or dad. We of course allow students to phone their parent or caregiver in the Front Office quickly under supervision. Your support of the school on this matter would be greatly appreciated. I see other schools struggling with the issues of regular phone usage which is problematic during school time both academically and socially for students.

Our consistent message to our students as parents / caregivers or teachers is to support them to make better decisions around the use of phones during the school day
